Fielding has over thirty-five years in the business and has done just about everything from birthday parties and school shows to headlining some of the biggest showrooms in Las Vegas. Fielding was a wealth of knowledge proving that simple is good. Aside from the obvious store bought magic props, the most expensive gimmick Fielding uses costs around a dollar and a half! One of Fielding's highlights was his dove harness. Advertised as the safest harness on the market. Also covered were balloon magic, coin magic, several of Fielding's routine direct from his comedy act and LOTS of philosophy on the art of entertaining. All in all, Fielding spent over three hours covering his fascinating life in magic.

Yes, none of us like to be told what we have worked on needs to be improved, and those who use this information will become better magicians and those who choose not to will just be doing tricks!
