## Ring Report

Ring 1 was fortunate to be able to host two excellent lectures this past month. The members look forward to learning new routines and effects from different lecturers. On May 16th, Adrian Vega lectured and on June 6th, Jason Ladanye lectured. Both of them were very knowledgeable and entertaining.

Adrian Vega is considered one of the best Close-Up Magicians from Spain. He has worked as a consultant for Chris Angel and has even performed with him. He has won numerous awards for his magic. Adrian has traveled to several countries and also to cities throughout the United States. He shared with the members several tricks which included "The Propheteer," "Screwed Card," "Secret Code", "Billing Card," "Scaandal," and "Deck Stab." Adrian had some of his effects for sale.

Jason's lecture was called, "The Game Changer Lecture." In his lecture, he taught seven high-impact card tricks. In addition to teaching the mechanics of these tricks, he also shared his insights on how to make one's show a show that no one will ever forget. He covered the following topics—effect construction, audience management, magic theory, misdirection, hecklers, developing one's character and persona, and how to maximize the impact of every trick. He also had DVDs, close-up mats, his book "The Game Changer", and lecture notes for sale.

D. Jay Lenz has really worked hard to ensure that at least two members visit Shriner's Hospital for Project Magic on the third Tuesday of each month. Dan Todd shared that he, along with John Davit, visited Shriner's in May and really felt the visit was very rewarding. They performed for approximately twelve people, with four of them being patients. Dan shared that the audience really enjoyed their performance. Dan performed the following—paper restoration (mouth coil), Indian Rope, and Chico the Mind Reader (Bill Abbott effect). John performed several card tricks and also made rings out of dollar bills for all the children. They also taught the children several tricks. Dan taught a paper ESP effect and John taught the linked-unlinked safety pin effect. The Ring does not meet in July since many members are on vacation. The meetings resume on August 1st for the annual Ice Cream Social. Ted Drewes frozen custard is served, which everyone looks forward to. Members are encouraged to bring their friends and relatives to this event. There will also be a flea market that night so members need to "look for all the magic they never use that is stored somewhere in their house." They can make money by selling the items, but magicians find it hard to part with magic, even if it is not used. The President's Banquet will be held on September 28th at Orlando's Banquet Center located in Maryland Heights, MO. The entertainment is still being negotiated. Again, this banquet will be a joint endeavor between IBM Ring 1 and S.A.M. Assembly 8. Last year, the groups had a joint banquet and it was very successful.
